







A BRIEF OVERVIEW

In a gestational surrogacy arrangement, intended parents create embryos through in vitro fertilization (IVF). One or more of these embryos is implanted in the surrogate, who carries the child or children to term, but has no genetic relationship to them. Depending on the situation, an egg donor may be needed. In a commercial surrogacy agreement, surrogates receive compensation for helping the family build a family.




